A big "thank you" to Laurie Shaw and Carol Ledja for organizing our Weaver House service project.

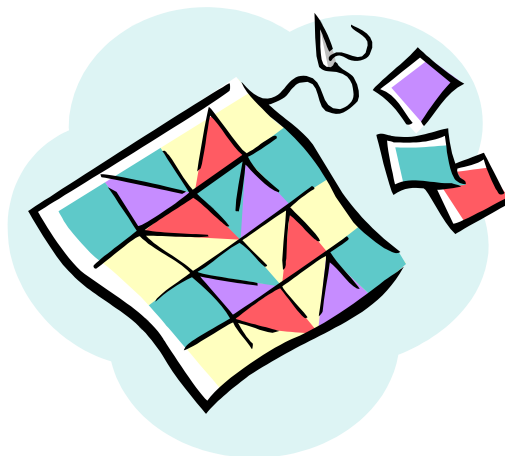
Have you made any quilting resolutions for 2012? I am going to try and complete one UFO per month. Maybe we can have a month by month count.

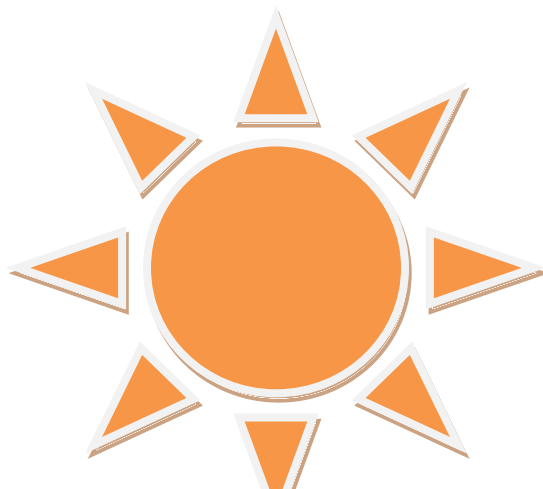
