antique quilts. But as usual they will go above and beyond antique quilts and provide an entertaining program.

They will also be bringing a small part of their shop to sell you some goodies.

The Pizza Girls will be hosting a workshop for our guild on Saturday November 4th. The workshop "**Embrace Your Curves**" is a 6-hour class focusing on technique to master curves.

Everyone loves the look of curves in a quilt, but often it is a technique that scares quilters. The Workshop will cover Rainbow Curves, Wheel of Mystery and Winner's Bouquet block. The cost of the class is \$50 plus \$9.00 kit w/ 3 different curved blocks. The Skill level: Confident beginner or intermediate.

There is still room in their Saturday workshop if you are interested. The kit will allow every student to get start sewing immediately not having to worry about any prep work. Please bring simple sewing supplies and their sewing machine. The class is about technique, not production. After the class, each student will have the option to purchase the template or ruler that we used in class, unless that is specified in the description. You will be able to decide after trying the technique if you want to do a big quilt or not. No special supplies are needed in order to take the class.

The workshop will be held at Lee's Chapel United Methodist Church on November 4th from 9am – 3:30pm. The address is 2303 Lee's Chapel Road, Greensboro 27405. Please plan on bringing a lunch.

Rules:

- Width No greater than 25 inches
- Length No greater than 44 inches
- 3 layers: top, batting and backing
- Quilted by hand or machine
- Any technique(s) and materials
- 3" hanging sleeve
- The challenge is open to Gate City Quilt Guild members only
- GCQG requests the right to display entries for up to two months following the show
